These discounts apply only to unmixed, same **VARIETY** flats (for example, a whole flat of Vodka begonias – not a flat of all kinds of begonias).

We do our best to ensure that we sell high quality plant material labeled true to name. If there is an error on our part, please contact us as soon as possible. With reasonable evidence of the error, we will gladly replace the plants or refund the original purchase price. However, our liability shall in no case exceed the original purchase price. **Many factors affect plant growth and health; therefore, we give NO WARRANTY EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED as to plant performance, bloom times, height, habit, or hardiness after you take possession of the plant material. We strongly recommend that plants break dormancy before they are purchased. We give NO WARRANTY on plants purchased while dormant.**

Likewise, we try to use good information on our tags and in our catalog. There are many opportunities for human error in the whole process of obtaining that information. Many of our tags come with the liners and the information contained is out of our control. Additionally, many plants may grow differently in different areas of the country. **Please keep this in mind when using the information provided to make buying decisions.**

### **Pot Sizes**

In the horticultural industry, pot sizes are many times somewhat smaller than what they are commonly called, much like 2" x 4" lumber is really 1.63" x 3.63". In an effort to minimize some of the confusion this creates, we want to clarify what you can expect with our most common sizes:

- Bedding plants are grown in an industry-standard 1020 flat (11" x 22"). There are 12 cell packs per flat with 3 or 4 plants per pack.
  - 2 ½" pots are 2.5" square by 3.25" to 3.5" deep and fit 32 to a flat. We may have availability of some items in a deep 6 pack which fit 36 plants per flat and are priced the same per plant as a 2 ½" pot.
  - 4" square pots are 3" to 3.5" wide by 3" to 3.5" deep (depending on the manufacturer) and fit 18 to a flat. They are approximately the same size as a traditional 4" square pot.
  - 4" round pots are 4" in diameter and 3.5" deep. Carry trays hold 14 pots per tray.
  - 4" round deep pots are 4" in diameter and 4.5" deep. Carry trays hold 10 pots per tray.
  - Round quart pots are approximately 4.7" in diameter by 4.5" deep and hold 1 quart of soil.
  - Square 2 quarts (5.5" square deep perennial pots) are 5.25" square by 7" deep and fit 8 pots to a 1020 flat for easy handling. They hold only slightly less soil than a trade gallon.
  - We do use full gallons on some items which are 7.5" wide by 7" deep. However, the majority of our gallon perennials are in trade (short) gallons that are 6" to 6.5" in diameter and 6" to 6.5" deep and hold about 2.68 quarts of soil. We are also using an 8" azalea pot (gallon) on some items that get fairly tall, because they have a wider footprint and are more stable. They are 8" in diameter by 6" deep and hold about 3.5 quarts.
  - 2 gallon containers are usually trade 2 gallons which are 8.5" wide by 8.5" deep and hold about 1.5 gallons.

- 3 gallon containers are usually trade 3 gallons which are 10" wide by 9" deep and hold about 2.33 gallons of soil.

We offer poinsettias in a wide range of colors and sizes. Please check with us in November for current pricing. We work with several churches and other organizations, so please consider us for your poinsettia needs.

### **Decorative Pottery**

We carry clay and plastic pottery, including strawberry jars, standard clay pots and other ornamental items. Our clay pot and saucer sizes start at 3" and go up to 20".

Most of the plants in our main perennial section show cold hardiness zones. The zones can sometimes change with the weather, and there are microclimates within zones (and often within individual gardens) in which the "rules" can be broken. The posted zones for any particular plant can also vary from one plant source to another. We use reputable sources for the information we list. **We hope the information is helpful, but please understand that it is not a guarantee of survival.** The USDA plant hardiness zone map is on our inside back cover for quick reference and you can learn more at <https://planthardiness.ars.usda.gov/>.

## Frequently Asked Questions

- **Is there a Mary/where is Mary?** There was a Mary. Mary Hamby started the business in the mid-1970s as a backyard hobby. She had always enjoyed growing plants and she discovered she had a real knack for growing. The business grew through the years, adding greenhouses as she expanded. Mary semi-retired in 2002 and could be seen working in her garden beside the Sales' Office. Mary passed away in August 2009. Mary's Greenhouse is still a family-owned business with several family members playing key roles.
  - **When is the best time to come for the biggest selection?** This is a difficult question to answer because it depends on the weather. If we have an early spring, it is best to visit early to mid-March for perennials or early to mid-April for annuals. If you want to try to get both perennials and annuals in one trip, plan to come early to mid-April. The perennial selection may not be as good, but if you are only planning one trip this would allow for more annuals to be available. If we have a late spring, you could probably delay your trip two to three weeks.
  - **Do you offer landscape design or installation?** Unfortunately, we do not. Our expertise lies with growing plants in a greenhouse environment. While we do have a display garden on site and are constantly trialing new plants, we don't have anyone on staff that is a designer or installer to give advice. Because our staff is spread very thin during the spring when most of our customers visit, it is unlikely we will be able to research detailed plant information for you. We find the internet to be a useful tool if you need more information about a specific plant. If you need a garden design, please contact a landscape business in your area. We do not keep a list of landscapers.
  - **How many greenhouses do you have?** We have 52 full-sized greenhouses plus a few smaller ones that we cover with plastic during the cold months. If you combine all sizes, there are 63 at present.
  - **Are you open all year?** Yes, we are. Our hours change with the seasons and we do close for extended periods in July and December.
  - **To whom do you sell?** We sell wholesale and retail, but we are primarily a wholesale operation selling to other greenhouses, landscapers, and independent garden centers. Retail customers are welcome; however, we are a self-service operation. Many of our customers view shopping at Mary's as an adventure. Wear your walking shoes, bring some water, and stay awhile.
  - **What is the difference between annuals and perennials?** Annuals have to be planted every year. One of the benefits of annuals is their show of colors through the spring or summer. Examples are begonias, marigolds, and petunias. Perennials are plants that come back every year but don't normally bloom as long as annuals. Perennial gardens are very popular today, but some of the best gardens combine both annuals and perennials to get the benefits of both.
  - **What is a biennial?** Generally a biennial takes 2 years to go through its life cycle. Plants usually grow leaves the first year and bloom and produce seed the next (many of the ones we grow are treated as perennials). Sweet William (*Dianthus barbatus*) is an example.

- **What is a native plant?** This question has been debated by gardeners for years and there are different schools of thought. To us at Mary's, a native is a plant that was already here in mainland America when the first Europeans arrived. We tend to be conservative as to whether a plant is still considered a native if the genetics have been tampered with, for instance, as in hybrids. In our catalog, we try to denote a plant as native if it is the species or it is a selection/cultivar of the species.
- **When is it safe to plant in the spring?** We wish we knew! Generally, it is safe to plant after any danger of frost for most annuals and garden vegetables like tomatoes and peppers. Depending upon whom you ask, frost free dates here in Middle Tennessee range from mid-April to mid-May. Don't be fooled by early warm temperatures – we can still have a killing frost. The first of May is usually safe for tender plants. For perennials, they usually can be planted as early as March if they have adjusted to the outside temperatures. If you want to get a jump start on spring and plant early, be prepared to cover your plants with some type of insulating cloth. Be careful with plastic as it will freeze the plants wherever it touches.

### Annuals

**Caladium 'Florida Sweetheart', 'Miss Muffet', and 'White Christmas'** are part of our caladium collection this spring. **'Florida Sweetheart'** is a popular strap leaf with pink leaves edged in green. **'Miss Muffet'** has white to light green leaves with lots of pink freckles. **'White Christmas'** has silver white leaves with dark green veins and margins.

**Calibrachoa 'Superbells®'** have several new varieties for 2019. We offer **'Double Chiffon'**, **'Doublette Love Swept™'**, **'Holy Cow™'**, **'Holy Smokes!™'**, **'Tangerine Punch™'**, and **'Cardinal Star™'**. **'Double Chiffon'** has light yellow, ruffled, double flowers and **'Doublette Love Swept™'** has hot rose pink double picotee blooms. **'Holy Cow™'** has hot pink striped flowers and **'Holy Smokes!™'** has pretty purple striped blooms. **'Tangerine Punch™'** is orange with a dark center while **'Cardinal Star™'** is a red and yellow star pattern. All are vibrant, eye-catching plants that bloom throughout the summer.

**Coleus 'Kong Jr.™ Lime Vein' and 'Scarlet'** have somewhat smaller leaves than their bigger cousins but still provide a big splash of color in the garden. **'Lime Vein'** has chartreuse leaves with burgundy centers and veining. **'Scarlet'** has dark burgundy leaves edged with lime green margins.

**Impatiens (Bedding) 'Imara™ XDR'** is the first series to have some resistance to downy mildew. We have **'Orange Star'**, **'Orange'**, **'Red'**, **'Rose'**, **'Violet'** and **'White'**.

**Impatiens (Double) 'Fiesta™'** have fully double blooms in a range of colors. Look for **'Cherry Sparkler'**, **'Pink'**, **'Purple'**, **'Salmon'**, **'Salsa Red'**, **'Stardust Lavender'**, and **'White'**.

**Petunia 'Easy Wave® Lavender Blue Sky'** joins the Wave® family. Blooms in shades of lavender and blue appear all summer. The colors lighten with higher light conditions.

**Petunia 'Headliner™ Night Sky' and 'Pink Sky'** are unusual spotted petunias. **'Night Sky'** is dark blue dotted with white (hence the name) and **'Pink Sky'** is hot pink with white spots. They are easy to grow and sure to draw attention. The spotted patterns may vary with temperatures and light levels.

## **Edibles, Herbs and Vegetables**

**Basil 'Everleaf Genovese'** blooms up to 8 weeks later than standard basil. It is well branched and stays tidy even with heavy harvesting. It is excellent for pesto and sauces and has improved resistance to downy mildew.

**Basil 'Red Boza'** is a dark leaved variety originating from Turkey and western Asia. The intense flavor and aroma make it excellent for cooking, salads, and vinegars while bringing a splash of color to your garden.

**Dill 'Greensleeves'** has dark green foliage and does well in field or pot production. It is very slow to bolt and tolerates hot summers.

**Eggplant 'Millionaire'** is a popular Japanese type with long slender black-purple fruits. The nearly seedless flesh is ideal for stir-fry and other Asian cuisine.

**Fennel 'Antares'** is an improved variety of fennel. It is slower to bolt and produces sweet, early bulbs with intensely fragrant and ornamental foliage. Fennel is an important food source of swallowtail butterflies and is a good choice for any butterfly garden.

**Lavender angustifolia 'Blue Cushion' PP#9119** is a dwarf and compact variety that blooms for weeks in the summer. The deep blue flowers age to a light blue producing a beautiful display. Deadheading promotes rebloom. Zones 5-9.

**Lavender angustifolia 'Blue Spear'** is a showy English type with lots of big, tall, dark blue spikes during the summer. It grows 13" and is hardy in zones 6-8.

**Mint 'After Eight'** has dark leaves with a wonderful minty chocolate flavor. Can be used in teas, salads and baking.

**Mint 'Cotton Candy'** has green foliage and pink flowers with an aroma reminiscent of cotton candy.

**Mint 'Kentucky Colonel'** is a popular spearmint with a strong scent and dark green leaves. It is a favorite for drinks and fruit salads.

**Pepper 'Bhut Jolokia Red' (aka Ghost Pepper)** is a superhot pepper that customers have requested for years. The fruit matures to red, getting hotter as it ages. Use caution when harvesting and handling the mature fruits.

**Raspberry 'Nantahala' PP#20689** is a North Carolina State University introduction. Some of the benefits of this variety are later harvest time (late summer), large berries and good disease resistance. Zones 6-9.

**Thyme 'Cascata Lemonade'** is a trailing green leaved variety that smells like lemonade. It can be used to make lemonade, teas or used in culinary dishes.

**Tomato 'Black Cherry'** produces large clusters of small, sweet, almost-black cherry tomatoes. An heirloom, it is a favorite for salads and just eating off the vine.

**Tomato 'Red Grape'** produces clusters of red, baby grape tomatoes. Grape-like bunches contain 20 or more super sweet, crack-resistant fruits. It is best to stake or support plants.

### Perennials

**Achillea 'Sassy Summer' varieties 'Lemon' PPAF and 'Sunset' PPAF** grow to 28-36" but maintain strong sturdy stems while in bloom. **'Lemon'** is the earliest to bloom with bright yellow flowers while **'Sunset'** has dark orange flower heads that mature to yellow. Zones 3-8.

**Armeria pseudarmeria 'Ballerina Lilac'** forms a neat grass-like clump that is topped with lots of lilac-pink globe shaped flowers in the spring and early summer. Zones 7-9.

**Buddleja 'Humdinger® Lavender Cupcake' PP#28221** is a compact butterfly bush reaching 4'. The lavender-purple blooms can grow 12" long and persist from midsummer into fall. Zones 5-10.

**Clematis 'Still Waters™' PP#20372** is a large violet-blue, easy to grow clematis from Proven Winners®. It blooms on new and old wood and can be cut back to about 2' each spring if needed. Blooms in spring and summer.

**Coreopsis grandiflora 'Double the Sun'** has large semi-double golden yellow blooms 1-2 weeks earlier than similar varieties. It grows 14" with a neat mounded habit and can bloom for months. Zones 4-9.

**Coreopsis 'L'il Bang™ Orange Elf' PPAF** grows to 12" and is covered in bright orange and yellow blooms throughout the summer. It combines well with other perennials or can stand alone in the landscape. Zones 5-9.

**Dianthus 'American Pie™ Key Lime Pie' PPAF** has unusual white blooms with green centers. The scented flowers sit atop sturdy stems that are great for cutting. Zone 5.

**Dianthus 'SuperTrouper™ Red White'** has double red and white scented blooms that persist for weeks. Zones 6-9.

**Echeveria 'Burgundy Pearl'** has green rosettes with deep burgundy tips. Zone 9.

**Echinacea purpurea 'Green Twister'** is a natural mutation of the popular 'Magnus'. The unique bicolor daisy-like blooms change in color from lemon-green edges to a bright carmine-red center. It grows to 3' and is hardy in zones 3-8.

**Gaillardia aristata 'SpinTop Yellow Touch' PPAF** has vibrant red blooms edged in yellow. The plants grow about 12" and bloom through the summer months. Zones 4-9.

**Geum hybrid 'Cocktails™ Sangria'** grows to 14" and blooms red. It has good disease tolerance and is free flowering in the spring and early summer. Zones 5-7.

**Grass – Panicum 'Hot Rod' PPAF** begins to turn red quicker than others. It grows 3-4' and the blue-green foliage ages to a deep maroon color.

**Helleborus 'Frostkiss™ Pippa's Purple®' PP#27121** has outward facing rose-pink blooms with burgundy speckles. The marbled, evergreen foliage is an added bonus.

**Helleborus 'Honeymoon®' varieties: 'New York Night', 'Romantic Getaway', and 'Tropical Sunset'** have bold single blooms. **'New York Night'** has shades of black-purple, **'Romantic Getaway'** has white blooms with bold red centers, and **'Tropical Sunset'** has yellow blooms streaked red.

**Helleborus 'Ice N' Roses® Red' PPAF** has upward-facing flowers above glossy green foliage. It can bloom for months and is well suited for the Southeast.

**Helleborus 'Wedding Party™ Wedding Bells'** has 2 to 2 1/2" double, clear white blooms in the early spring.

**Hemerocallis (Daylily) 'Monterrey Jack'** boasts 5 1/2" light yellow flowers with a raspberry-red eye. The ruffled blooms appear early in the season.

**Heuchera 'Dolce® Wildberry' PPAF** and **'Primo® Mahogany Monster' PPAF** are 2 new coral bells from Proven Winners®. **'Wildberry'** has large scalloped dark purple leaves that hold their color well. **'Mahogany Monster'** is a villosa hybrid with big glossy red leaves that reach to 6" across. It will be available Summer 2019. Both are hardy in zones 4-9.

**Heuchera 'Guacamole' PPAF** has bright lime-green to chartreuse foliage that brightens up any shade garden. This vigorous variety can reach 2' across. Zones 4-9.

**Heuchera 'Red Lightning' PP#27767** produces large gold leaves with deep red veining in the spring. A villosa hybrid, it tolerates heat and humidity and makes a neat clump reaching to 18" wide. Zones 4-9.

**Hosta 'Coast to Coast' PP#26469** and **'Diamond Lake' PPAF** are part of the Shadowland® series from Proven Winners®. **'Coast to Coast'** boasts giant gold leaves that form a vase-shaped clump. **'Diamond Lake'** has large, heart-shaped blue leaves that reach 9" wide.

**Hosta 'Dancing Queen'** is the 2020 Hosta of the Year. With pretty yellow foliage that holds its color well, it is an improvement over older yellow varieties. The clump grows 18" with scapes reaching 28".

**Hosta 'School Mouse' PPAF** has coarse blue-green leaves with a prominent yellow margin. It is another popular 'Mouse' variety and grows 8" up to 14" with bloom scapes.

**Hosta 'Sun Mouse' PPAF** is a miniature (6") hosta with bright yellow foliage. It resembles 'Blue Mouse Ears' in shape and performance although it is a bit shorter and wider.

**Iberis amara 'Summer Snowdrift' PPAF** is a new candytuft that blooms weeks longer than traditional types. The snow-white blooms appear in early spring and persist into the summer months. Can be used in mixed containers. Zones 6-9.

**Iris (Dwarf) 'Cat's Eye' and 'Trajectory'** are our new dwarf varieties for 2019. **'Cat's Eye'** grows to 15" and is a fragrant, cherry-red and rose bicolor.

**'Trajectory'** grows 13" and the dark purple blooms have white patches on the falls.

**Iris (German) 'Blueberry Bliss', 'Concertina', 'Disco Music', 'Innocent Star', 'Midnight Treat', 'Rock Star', and 'Rosalie Figge'** are new additions to our iris collection. **'Blueberry Bliss'** has ruffled navy blue blooms early in the season.

**'Concertina'** is an intermediate, reblooming rose-pink iris with delightful blue beards. **'Disco Music'** is a mid-season bright orange. **'Innocent Star'** is an early season, reblooming burgundy wine plicata. **'Midnight Treat'** is an early blooming unusual purple and black bicolor. **'Rock Star'** is a reblooming raspberry-rose plicata that grows to 30". **'Rosalie Figge'** is a sweetly scented, reblooming purple.

**Iris laevigata 'Variegata'** is a brightly striped water iris with blue blooms in the spring to early summer. It grows in up to 8" of standing water and is hardy in zones 5-9. Attractive to hummingbirds.

**Kniphofia 'Winners Club™' varieties 'Jackpot' PPAF and 'Lucky Lemons' PPAF** have upright foliage with lots of bloom power. **'Jackpot'** is a rebloomer, growing 3' with reddish orange and yellow blooms. **'Lucky Lemons'** grows 4' with yellow blooms that appear two-toned as they age. Zones 5-9.

**Lagerstroemia (Crape Myrtle) 'Barista®' varieties 'Brew Ha Ha' PPAF and 'Cherry Mocha' PPAF** are part of a hardy collection of crape myrtles that have overwintered well in zone 6. **'Brew Ha Ha'** has bubblegum pink flowers atop dark foliage while **'Cherry Mocha'** has cherry red flowers. Both grow 2-3'.

**Mangave 'Mad About Mangave®' varieties 'Crazy Cowlick' PPAF and 'Whale Tale' PPAF** are from Walters Gardens. **'Crazy Cowlick'** has pretty spotted green leaves with dark margins and spines. The brown spots are heavier towards the center and lighten as the leaves mature. **'Whale Tale'** has wide, silvery blue-green leaves that arch downward. Mangaves are faster growers than agaves, have softer spines and make great containers either with other succulents or alone.

**Nepeta 'Cat's Pajamas' PPAF** is a petite catmint from Proven Winners®. Growing only about 15", the rich blue flowers appear 2-3 weeks earlier than some varieties and it blooms along the whole stem, from top to bottom. Zones 3-8.

**Phlox subulata hybrid (Hybrid Spring Phlox) 'Pink Minuet' PPAF** is a hybrid phlox that blooms in between subulata and paniculata varieties. It grows to 10" and has rosy pink flowers over dark green foliage. Zones 3-8.

**Rose (Miniature) 'Parade® Gigi' PPAF, 'Patio Hit®' varieties 'Darla™' PPAF, 'Fiesta™' PP#11509, 'Yumi™' PP#26868, and 'Snow Bride'** have attractive green foliage with bushy habits and range from 1-2' tall. **'Gigi'** is the shortest, growing to 12", and has red and white blooms. **'Darla'** is a rich red; **'Fiesta'** is a magenta-pink; and **'Yumi'** is a bright yellow. **'Snow Bride'** has pure white blooms.

**Salvia nemorosa 'Sallyrosa™ Jumbo Pink' PPAF** is a pink perennial salvia growing to 16". It is long blooming and drought tolerant once established. It should be deadheaded to help repeat blooming. Zones 5-8.

**Sedum 'Steel the Show' PPAF** has blue-green foliage and rose-pink blooms in late summer. It makes a good groundcover as it grows only about 8". Zones 3-9.

**Sedum 'Little Miss Sunshine' PPAF** is a groundcover sedum with dark green foliage topped with bright yellow flowers in the summer. Zones 3-9.

**Stachys monieri 'Hummelo'** is the 2019 PPA Plant of the Year. Spikes of rose-purple flowers rise above textured green foliage during the summer. It grows to 20" and is hardy in zones 4-8.

**Syringa 'Bloomerang® Dwarf Pink' PPAF** is a reblooming pink that grows 2-3'. This sweetly scented lilac is easier to tuck into smaller spaces. Zone 3. Proven Winners®.
