<b>Annuals</b>			
<b>Angelonia 'AngelMist®'</b> is a spreading angelonia suitable for baskets, containers or in the ground. We have ' <b>Berry Sparkler</b> ', ' <b>Dark Purple</b> ', and ' <b>White</b> '. <i>Limited Supply beginning in April.</i>			
<b>Begonia 'Bada Bing'</b> is a green leaf series that provide bright color all summer long. We offer ' <b>Mix</b> ', ' <b>Rose</b> ', ' <b>Scarlet</b> ' and ' <b>White</b> '.			
<b>Begonia 'Bossa Nova'</b> is a boliviensis begonia that blooms from spring to frost. We have ' <b>Night Fever Papaya</b> ' and ' <b>Yellow</b> ', both of which are well branched and self cleaning.			
<b>Begonia 'Funky® Orange'</b> joins the popular 'Funky® Pink'. They both have large, double, novel blooms that brighten shady spots.			
<b>Begonia 'RiseUp'</b> are hybrid begonias that are known for their branching and flowering ability. These produce a multitude of medium sized double blooms just above the foliage and are ideal for baskets and containers. We have ' <b>Flamingo Dream</b> ' , ' <b>Grenadine Red</b> ', ' <b>Salmon Chiffon</b> ', and ' <b>Sansibel Peach</b> '.			
<b>Caladium 'Florida Sweetheat', 'Miss Muffet', and 'White Christmas'</b> are part of our caladium collection this spring. ' <b>Florida Sweetheart</b> ' is a popular strap leaf with pink leaves edged in green. ' <b>Miss Muffet</b> ' has white to light green leaves with lots of pink freckles. ' <b>White Christmas</b> ' has silver white leaves with dark green veins and margins.			
<b>Calendula 'Lady Godiva™ Yellow'</b> is a new addition to Proven Winners®. The yellow flowers attract bees and butterflies through the summer.			
<b>Calibrachoa 'Superbells®'</b> have several new varieties for 2019. We offer ' <b>Double Chiffon</b> ', ' <b>Doublette Love Swept™</b> ', ' <b>Holy Cow™</b> ', ' <b>Holy Smokes!™</b> ', ' <b>Tangerine Punch™</b> ', and ' <b>Cardinal Star™</b> '. ' <b>Double Chiffon</b> ' has light yellow, ruffled, double flowers and ' <b>Doublette Love Swept™</b> ' has hot rose pink picotee double blooms. ' <b>Holy Cow™</b> ' has hot pink striped flowers and ' <b>Holy Smokes!™</b> ' has pretty purple striped blooms. ' <b>Tangerine Punch™</b> ' is orange with a dark center while ' <b>Cardinal Star™</b> ' is a red and yellow star pattern. All are vibrant, eye-catching plants that bloom throughout the summer. Proven Winners®.			
<b>Celosia 'Armor Orange' and 'Purple'</b> are crested celosia types that grow 12-16".			
<b>Celosia 'First Flame™ Mix'</b> is a feather type celosia that blooms up to 2 weeks earlier than others on the market.			
<b>Coleus 'Colorblaze® Sedona Sunset™'</b> is an improvement of the popular 'Sedona'. Brightly colored foliage makes for an attractive container or landscape plant. Proven Winners®.			
<b>Coleus 'Kong Jr.™ Lime Vein' and 'Scarlet'</b> have somewhat smaller leaves than their bigger cousins but still provide a big splash of color in the garden. ' <b>Lime Vein</b> ' has chartreuse leaves with burgundy centers and veining. ' <b>Scarlet</b> ' has dark burgundy leaves edged with lime green margins.			
<b>Dahlia 'Dahlietta®'</b> is a series of compact, easy to grow, early blooming dahlias. Look for ' <b>Coby</b> ' (2 tone yellow), ' <b>Leanne</b> ' (purple), ' <b>Lily</b> ' (salmon), ' <b>Marissa</b> ' (yellow/red bicolor), ' <b>Rachel</b> ' (orange), and ' <b>Tessy</b> ' (red).			
<b>Dahlia 'Dalaya™ Pink Lemon' and 'Red White'</b> are two-toned dahlias growing 16-18". Both are unusual and eye catching. <i>Limited Supply beginning in April.</i>			

<b>Dipladenia 'Madinia™ Coral Pink'</b> is hot pink and new for 2019. These have a limited vining habit and bloom nonstop through the summer.			
<b>Euphorbia 'Diamond Mountain™'</b> is a larger version of the the popular 'Diamond Frost®'. Performs well in large containers or in the landscape. Proven Winners®.			
<b>Fuchsia 'Autumnale Chartreuse', 'Dollar Princess', 'Standup Red/White'</b> are new at Mary's. <b>'Autumnale Chartreuse'</b> has trailing chartreuse and maroon foliage with magenta-red blooms. <b>'Dollar Princess'</b> is an upright plant with double red and purple blooms. <b>'Standup Red/White'</b> has red and white blooms with an upright habit.			
<b>Geranium (Exotic) 'Occold Shield'</b> has coral-red blooms atop two-toned foliage. The leaves have a maroon center with green-gold margins.			
<b>Gomphrena 'Truffula™ Pink'</b> is a pink gomphrena reaching 28" with multitudes of cotton ball sized blooms during the summer. Does well in mixed containers or in the landscape. Gomphrena attracts a variety of pollinators. Proven Winners®.			
<b>Impatiens (Bedding) 'Imara™ XDR'</b> is the first series to have <u>some</u> resistance to downy mildew. We have <b>'Orange Star', 'Orange', 'Red', 'Rose', 'Violet' and 'White'</b> .			
<b>Impatiens (Double) 'Fiesta™'</b> have fully double blooms in a range of colors. Look for <b>'Cherry Sparkler', 'Pink', 'Purple', 'Salmon', 'Salsa Red', 'Stardust Lavender', and 'White'</b> .			
<b>Impatiens (New Guinea) 'ColorPower™'</b> is an early blooming, large flowered series with a multitude of colors. We have <b>'Dark Red', 'Lavender Flame', 'Rose' and 'White'</b> in limited quantities.			
<b>Impatiens 'Sunpatiens® Compact Pink Candy'</b> has a pink striped bloom. Sunpatiens® grow in sun or shade and tolerate a variety of weaher conditions.			
<b>Mandevilla 'Sun Parasol® Giant Marbled Crimson' PPAF</b> is a new variegated vining mandevilla from Suntory. Bright green and white leaves with big rich red blooms catch your attention.			
<b>Marigold 'Hot Pak™ Flame'</b> is part of a new series of french marigold that was developed for the heat of our summers. The compact plants bloom through the hottest parts of the summer.			
<b>Osteospermum 'Bright Lights™ Pink'</b> has pretty pink blooms atop the green foliage. Proven Winners®.			
<b>Petunia (Petchoa) 'SuperCal® Premium Bordeaux', 'Cinnamon', and 'Caramel Yellow'</b> have larger flowers and a more refined habit while still being known as the 'all weather petunia'.			
<b>Petunia 'Crazytunia Razzamatazz' and 'Pulse'</b> are uniquely striped petunias that will liven up your containers and mixed pots.			
<b>Petunia 'Easy Wave® Lavender Blue Sky'</b> joins the Wave® family. Blooms in shades of lavender and blue appear all summer. The colors lighten with higher light conditions.			
<b>Petunia 'Headliner™ Night Sky' and 'Pink Sky'</b> are unusual spotted petunias. <b>'Night Sky'</b> is dark blue dotted with white (hence the name) and <b>'Pink Sky'</b> is hot pink with white spots. They are easy to grow and sure to draw attention. The spotted patterns may vary with temperatures and light levels.			
<b>Petunia 'Sun Spun® Raspberry Star'</b> is a raspberry-red and white striped petunia that can be grown in containers or in the ground. It has a nice compact habit that makes it ideal for mixed combos.			
<b>Petunia 'Supertunia® Blue Skies'</b> has loads of light blue blooms and combines well in mixed containers or on its own. Proven Winners®.			

<b>Purslane 'ColorBlast Pink Lady'</b> has bright hot pink and white striped flowers all summer. Can be used in baskets, containers or as a groundcover.			
<b>Purslane 'Rio Grande™'</b> has large, vibrant blooms in a variety of colors. <i>Available in limited quantities beginning in April.</i>			
<b>Scaevola 'Whirlwind™ Pink'</b> is the newest addition to the 'Whirlwind™' family with bright pink flowers. It is easy to grow and makes a colorful groundcover or container plant. Proven Winners®.			
<b>Shrimp Plant (Justicia b. Variegata) 'Shrimp &amp; Grits'</b> is a brightly variegated plant with pink blooms that resemble shrimp.			
<b>Thunbergia 'Sunny™ Lemon Star' and 'Orange Wonder'</b> are yellow and orange (respectively) black-eyed susan vines. The vigorous vines bloom all summer. <i>Limited quantities beginning in April.</i>			
<b>Verbena 'Superbena® Raspberry', 'Red', and 'Whiteout™'</b> join Proven Winners®. All three are mounding/trailing with bright clean flowers. They are ideal for baskets and mixed containers.			
<b>Vinca 'Tattoo Black Cherry' and 'Papaya'</b> are free flowering, well branched plants with unique flowers. <b>'Black Cherry'</b> is a cherry-red with blackish highlights. <b>'Papaya'</b> is a soft orange with prominent black eyes.			
<b>Edibles, Herbs and Vegetables</b>			
<b>Basil 'Everleaf Genovese'</b> blooms up to 8 weeks later than standard basil. It is well branched and stays tidy even with heavy harvesting. It is excellent for pesto and sauces and has improved resistance to downy mildew.			
<b>Basil 'Red Boza'</b> is a dark leaved variety originating from Turkey and western Asia. The intense flavor and aroma make it excellent for cooking, salads, and vinegars while bringing a splash of color to your garden.			
<b>Dill 'Greensleeves'</b> has dark green foliage and does well in field or pot production. It is very slow to bolt and tolerates hot summers.			
<b>Eggplant 'Millionaire'</b> is a popular Japanese type with long slender black-purple fruits. The nearly seedless flesh is ideal for stir-fry and other Asian cuisine.			
<b>Fennel 'Antares'</b> is an improved variety of fennel. It is slower to bolt and produces sweet, early bulbs with intensely fragrant and ornamental foliage. Fennel is an important food source of swallowtail butterflies and is a good choice for any butterfly garden.			
<b>Lavender angustifolia 'Blue Cushion' PP#9119</b> is a dwarf and compact variety that blooms for weeks in the summer. The deep blue flowers age to a light blue producing a beautiful display. Deadheading promotes rebloom. Zones 5-9.			
<b>Lavender angustifolia 'Blue Spear'</b> is a showy English type with lots of big, tall, dark blue spikes during the summer. It grows 13" and is hardy in zones 6-8.			
<b>Lavender stoechas 'Anouk Deep Rose' PP#26493</b> is a hardy Spanish type with lavender-rose blooms in the summer. It does well in containers or in the ground and is more resistant to foliar diseases. Zones 6-9.			
<b>Mint 'After Eight'</b> has dark leaves with a wonderful minty chocolate flavor. Can be used in teas, salads and baking.			
<b>Mint 'Cotton Candy'</b> has green foliage and pink flowers with a aroma reminiscent of cotton candy.			

<b>Mint 'Kentucky Colonel'</b> is a popular spearmint with a strong scent and dark green leaves. It is a favorite for drinks and fruit salads.			
<b>Raspberry 'Nantahala' PP#20689</b> is a North Carolina State University introduction. Some of the benefits of this variety are later harvest time (late summer), large berries and good disease resistance. Zones 6-9.			
<b>Pepper 'Bhut Jolokia Red' (aka Ghost Pepper)</b> is a super hot pepper that customers have requested for years. The fruit matures to red, getting hotter as it ages. Use caution when harvesting and handling the mature fruits.			
<b>Thyme 'Cascata Lemonade'</b> is a trailing green leafed variety that smells like lemonade. It can be used to make lemonade, teas or used in culinary dishes.			
<b>Tomato 'Black Cherry'</b> produces large clusters of small, sweet, almost-black cherry tomatoes. An heirloom, it is a favorite for salads and just eating off the vine.			
<b>Tomato 'Red Grape'</b> produces clusters of red, baby grape tomatoes. Grape-like bunches contain 20 or more super sweet, crack resistant fruits. It is best to stake or support plants.			
<b>Perennials</b>			
<b>Achillea 'Ritzy Rose' PPAF</b> grows to 14" and has dark rose pink blooms appearing in spring and continuing into summer. Zones 4-8.			
<b>Achillea 'Sassy Summer' varieties 'Lemon' PPAF and 'Sunset' PPAF</b> grow to 28-36" but maintain strong sturdy stems while in bloom. <b>'Lemon'</b> is the earliest to bloom with bright yellow flowers while <b>'Sunset'</b> has dark orange flower heads that mature to yellow. Zones 3-8.			
<b>Achillea ptarmica 'Peter Cottontail' PPAF</b> has large ivory-white flowers in the summer atop a mounding plant. It grows to 24" and deer and rabbits usually leave it alone. Zones 3-8.			
<b>Agastache 'Red Fortune' PP#11816</b> has magenta-red flower spikes that are excellent for cutting. The wonderfully scented foliage and blooms are edible and butterflies love it. The plants grow 24-30" and are hardy in zones 4-9.			
<b>Ajuga 'Blueberry Muffin' PP#22092</b> is a vigorous small-leafed variety from Terra Nova Nurseries. Spikes up to 8" appear with blueberry-blue blooms in the spring and early spring. Zones 5-9.			
<b>Alcea ficifolia 'Las Vegas'</b> is a hardy and longer-lived hollyhock. The plants reach 6' in bloom with a wide color range of large flowers including reds, yellows, pinks and white. Zone 3.			
<b>Alstroemeria 'Inca Ice™'</b> is a Peruvian Lily that grows 2-3' tall and has salmon pink and creamy yellow flowers in large clusters. It is considered hardier than some varieties and was bred for garden use. Zone 6. <i>Limited quantities.</i>			
<b>Anemone 'September Charm'</b> is a Japanese type anemone and has an abundance of single rose-pink flowers in late summer.			
<b>Armeria pseudarmeria 'Ballerina Lilac'</b> forms a neat grass-like clump that is topped with lots of lilac-pink globe shaped flowers in the spring and early summer. Zones 7-9.			
<b>Aster 'Island™ Tonga'</b> is covered in semi-double pinkish purple blooms in late summer for several weeks. Established plants grow to 2' and work well either in containers or in the landscape.			
<b>Aster 'Kickin® Pink Chiffon'</b> has pastel pink flowers on a plant reaching 3'. The 'Kickin®' series are known for their disease resistance and bloom power.			

<b>Buddleja 'Humdinger® Lavender Cupcake' PP#28221</b> is a compact butterfly bush reaching 4'. The lavender-purple bloom panicles can grow 12" long and persist from midsummer into fall. Zones 5-10.			
<b>Campanula hybrid 'Pink Octopus' PP#18885</b> is a vigorous plant that covers itself in pretty pink octopus-like blooms in early summer. It can bloom for weeks and is purported to do well in the South. Zones 5-9.			
<b>Clematis 'Still Waters™' PP#20372</b> is a large violet-blue, easy to grow clematis from Proven Winners®. It blooms on new and old wood and can be cut back to about 2' each spring if needed. Blooms in spring and summer.			
<b>Coreopsis grandiflora 'Double the Sun'</b> has large semi-double golden yellow blooms 1-2 weeks earlier than similar varieties. It grows 14" with a neat mounded habit and can bloom for months. Zones 4-9.			
<b>Coreopsis 'L'il Bang™ Orange Elf' PPAF</b> grows to 12" and is covered in bright orange and yellow blooms throughout the summer. It combines well with other perennials or can stand alone in the landscape. Zones 5-9.			
<b>Delphinium elatum 'Delphina™ Dark Blue White Bee'</b> is part of a new series that grows to 18". Bloom spikes of rich dark blue flowers with white bees appear in early spring. Zones 4-8.			
<b>Dianthus 'American Pie™ Key Lime Pie' PPAF</b> has unusual white blooms with green centers. The scented flowers sit atop sturdy stems that are great for cutting. Zone 5.			
<b>Dianthus 'EverLast™ Lavender Lace' PPAF</b> is an early blooming, fragrant variety producing single raspberry red blooms with lavender-pink edges. Zones 5-10.			
<b>Dianthus 'Scent First™ Sugar Plum' PP#21398</b> is a free flowering, scented, double maroon and pink variety. It has long stems for cutting. Zones 5-9.			
<b>Dianthus 'SuperTrouper™ Red White'</b> has double red and white scented blooms that persist for weeks. Zones 6-9.			
<b>Digitalis 'Dalmation Purple' and 'Dalmation Rose'</b> have excellent branching and neat habit. These grow 2-3' and have strong flower spikes with rich colors. Zones 5-9.			
<b>Echeveria 'Burgundy Pearl' and elegans 'Blue'</b> are 2 new showy varieties for this year. <b>'Burgundy Pearl'</b> has green rosettes with deep burgundy tips. <b>Elegans 'Blue'</b> makes a pretty, tight clump of blue-green rounded succulent leaves. Zone 9.			
<b>Echinacea hybrid 'Double Scoop™ Cranberry' PP#24769 and 'Double Scoop™ Mandarin' PP#26640</b> have large, fragrant, pompom flowers that resist fading in the heat. They grow 26". Zones 4-9.			
<b>Echinacea hybrid 'Sombrero® Tres Amigos' PPAF</b> presents 3 colors at once. The blooms open a peachy-coral, age rose and then fade to burgundy. This unique bloomer grows about 20" and is well branched and floriferous. Zones 4-9.			
<b>Echinacea purpurea 'Cone-fections™ Butterfly Kisses' PP#24458</b> is free flowering double that produces large pink flowers. It is a compact grower reaching 15". Zones 4-9.			
<b>Echinacea purpurea 'Green Twister'</b> is a natural mutation of the popular 'Magnus'. The unique bicolor daisy-like blooms change in color from lemon-green edges to a bright carmine-red center. It grows to 3' and is hardy in zones 3-8.			
<b>Echinacea tennesseensis (TN Coneflower) 'Rocky Top'</b> is a Tennessee native wildflower that has pink daisy-like blooms in the summer. It normally grows to 30" and is hardy in zones 5-8.			
<b>Fern 'Five-Finger Maidenhair' (Adiantum pedatum)</b> is native to this area and produces graceful, lacy fronds. It grows 12 – 30" and once established, will thrive in moist, shady places.			

<b>Gaillardia aristata 'SpinTop Yellow Touch' PPAF</b> has vibrant red blooms edged in yellow. The plants grow about 12" and bloom through the summer months. Zones 4-9.			
<b>Geranium pretense 'Dark Reiter'</b> has finely cut, dark purple leaves and lilac-blue flowers. The compact mound reaches about 12" and blooms in early summer. Zones 4-8.			
<b>Geum hybrid 'Cocktails™ Sangria'</b> grows to 14" and blooms red. It has good disease tolerance and is free flowering in the spring and early summer. Zones 5-7.			
<b>Grass (Ornamental) Carex 'ColorGrass® Red Rooster'</b> has been a favorite of ours in the past. <b>'Red Rooster'</b> has upright bronze foliage and does well in mixed containers or in the landscape.			
<b>Grass (Ornamental) Festuca glauca 'Beyond Blue' PP#23307</b> is a naturally occurring mutation of 'Elijah Blue'. It has intense icy blue foliage and is purported to be tolerant of dry, poor landscapes.			
<b>Grass (Ornamental) Panicum 'Hot Rod' PPAF</b> begins to turn red quicker than others. It grows 3-4' and the blue-green foliage ages to a deep maroon color.			
<b>Grass (Ornamental) 'Burgundy Bunny' PP#21917</b> forms a tight green clump with red accents. The clump ages to red as fall arrives. Grows 18" and hardy in Zones 6(5)-9.			
<b>Helleborus x 'Ice N' Roses® Red' PPAF</b> has upward-facing flowers above glossy green foliage. It can bloom for months and is well suited for the Southeast.			
<b>Helleborus x (Lenten Rose) 'Frostkiss™ Pippa's Purple®' PP#27121</b> has outward facing rose-pink blooms with burgundy speckles. The marbled, evergreen foliage is an added bonus.			
<b>Helleborus 'Honeymoon®' varieties: 'New York Night', 'Romantic Getaway', and 'Tropical Sunset'</b> have bold single blooms. <b>'New York Night'</b> has shades of black-purple, <b>'Romantic Getaway'</b> has white blooms with bold red centers, and <b>'Tropical Sunset'</b> has yellow blooms streaked red.			
<b>Helleborus 'Wedding Party™ Wedding Bells'</b> has 2-2 1/2" double, clear white blooms in the early spring.			
<b>Hemerocallis (Daylily) 'Monterrey Jack'</b> boasts 5 1/2" light yellow flowers with a raspberry-red eye. The ruffled blooms appear early in the season.			
<b>Heuchera 'Dolce® Wildberry' PPAF and 'Primo® Mahogany Monster' PPAF</b> are 2 new coral bells from Proven Winners®. <b>'Wildberry'</b> has large scalloped dark purple leaves that hold their color well. <b>'Mahogany Monster'</b> is a villosa hybrid with big glossy red leaves that reach to 6" across. It will be available Summer 2019. Both are hardy in zones 4-9.			
<b>Heuchera 'Primo® Peachberry Ice' PPAF</b> has large bright apricot-orange leaves that mellow with warmer temperatures. The foliage grows 8-10" and it is hardy in zones 4-9. Proven Winners®. <i>Limited quantities.</i>			
<b>Heuchera 'Guacamole' PPAF</b> has bright lime-green to chartreuse foliage that brightens up any shade garden. This vigorous variety can reach 2' across. Zones 4-9.			
<b>Heuchera 'Red Lightning' PP#27767</b> produces large gold leaves with deep red veining in the spring. A villosa hybrid, it tolerates heat and humidity and makes a neat clump reaching to 18" wide. Zones 4-9.			
<b>Hibiscus moscheutos 'Disco Belle' varieties: 'Pink', 'Rosy Red' and 'White'</b> are long time favorites with 8" wide blooms. These varieties get 3-4' tall and are hardy in zones 5-10. <i>Available late Spring 2019.</i>			

<b>Hibiscus moscheutos 'Flemings' varieties 'Fireball™' PP#13631, 'Old Yella™' PP#23698, and 'Plum Crazy™' PP#11854</b> are hardy hibiscus that grow 3-4' and are covered in 12" blooms all summer long. <b>'Fireball™'</b> is deep red, <b>'Old Yella™'</b> is pale yellow, and <b>'Plum Crazy™'</b> is plum-purple. All are hardy in zones 4-11. <i>Available late Spring 2019.</i>			
<b>Hibiscus moscheutos 'Starry Starry Night' PP#27901</b> has dark foliage with large pink blooms that are speckled and veined a darker pink. It grows to 4' and is hardy to zone 4-9. <i>Available late Spring 2019.</i>			
<b>Hosta 'Coast to Coast' PP#26469 and 'Diamond Lake' PPAF</b> are part of the Shadowland® series from Proven Winners®. <b>'Coast to Coast'</b> boasts giant gold leaves that form a vase-shaped clump. <b>'Diamond Lake'</b> has large, heart-shaped blue leaves that reach 9" wide.			
<b>Hosta 'Dancing Queen'</b> is the 2020 Hosta of the Year. With pretty yellow foliage that holds its color well, it is an improvement over older yellow varieties. The clump grows 18" with scapes reaching 28".			
<b>Hosta 'School Mouse' PPAF</b> has coarse blue-green leaves with a prominent yellow margin. It is another popular 'Mouse' variety and grows 8" up to 14" with bloom scapes.			
<b>Hosta 'Sun Mouse' PPAF</b> is a miniature (6") hosta with bright yellow foliage. It resembles 'Blue Mouse Ears' in shape and performance although it is a bit shorter and wider.			
<b>Iberis amara 'Summer Snowdrift' PPAF</b> is a new candytuft that blooms weeks longer than traditional types. The snow white blooms appear in early spring and persist into the summer months. Can be used in mixed containers. Zones 6-9.			
<b>Iris dwarf 'Cat's Eye' and 'Trajectory'</b> are our new dwarf varieties for 2019. 'Cat's Eye' grows to 15" and is a fragrant, cherry-red and rose bicolor. 'Trajectory' grows 13" and the dark purple blooms have white patches on the falls.			
<b>Iris german 'Blueberry Bliss', 'Concertina', 'Disco Music', 'Innocent Star', 'Midnight Treat', 'Rock Star', and 'Rosalie Figge'</b> are new additions to our iris collection. <b>'Blueberry Bliss'</b> has ruffled navy blue blooms early in the season. <b>'Concertina'</b> is an intermediate, reblooming rose-pink iris with delightful blue beards. <b>'Disco Music'</b> is a mid-season bright orange. <b>'Innocent Star'</b> an early season, reblooming burgundy wine plicata. <b>'Midnight Treat'</b> is an early blooming unusual purple and black bicolor. <b>'Rock Star'</b> is a reblooming raspberry-rose plicata that grows to 30". <b>'Rosalie Figge'</b> is a sweetly scented, reblooming purple.			0
<b>Iris laevigata 'Variegata'</b> is a brightly striped water iris with blue blooms in the spring to early summer. It grows in up to 8" standing water and is hardy in zones 5-9. Attractive to hummingbirds.			
<b>Kniphofia 'Winners Club™' varieties 'Jackpot' PPAF and 'Lucky Lemons' PPAF</b> have upright foliage with lots of bloom power. <b>'Jackpot'</b> is a rebloomer, growing 3' with reddish orange and yellow blooms. <b>'Lucky Lemons'</b> grows 4' with yellow blooms that appear two-toned as they age. Zones 5-9.			
<b>Lagerstroemia (Crape Myrtle) 'Barista®' varieties 'Brew Ha Ha' PPAF and 'Cherry Mocha' PPAF</b> are part of a hardy collection of crape myrtles that have overwintered well in zone 6. <b>'Brew Ha Ha'</b> has bubblegum pink flowers atop dark foliage while <b>'Cherry Mocha'</b> has cherry red flowers. Both grow 2-3'.			
<b>Leucanthemum (Shasta Daisy) 'Real Sunbeam' PPAF</b> has single, bright yellow flowers atop strong stems. It is best to deadhead to promote rebloom and is hardy in zones 5-9.			

<b>Mangave ‘Mad About Mangave®’ varieties ‘Crazy Cowlick’ PPAF and ‘Whale Tale’ PPAF</b> are from Walters Gardens. <b>'Crazy Cowlick'</b> has pretty spotted green leaves with dark margins and spines. The brown spots are heavier towards the center and lighten as the leaves mature. <b>'Whale Tale'</b> has wide, silvery blue-green leaves that arch downward. Mangaves are faster growers than agaves, have softer spines and make great containers either with other succulents or alone.			
<b>Mangave ‘Mad About Mangave®’ varieties ‘Purple People Eater’ PPAF, ‘Red Wing’ PPAF. 'Purple People Eater'</b> has thick, densely spotted blue-green leaves that appear purple (hence the name). <b>'Red Wing'</b> has deep red foliage that forms a large rosette. Zone 9. <i>Available Summer 2019.</i>			
<b>Monarda (Bee Balm) ‘Sugar Buzz®’ varieties: ‘Bubblegum Blast’ PP#27497 and ‘Rockin’ Raspberry’ PP#28752</b> have attractive green foliage with excellent mildew resistance and grow about 2' tall. <b>'Bubblegum Blast'</b> has hot pink flowers and <b>'Rockin Raspberry'</b> has raspberry-purple blooms.			
<b>Nepeta ‘Cat’s Pajamas’ PPAF</b> is a petite catmint from Proven Winners®. Growing only about 15", the rich blue flowers appear 2-3 weeks earlier than some varieties and it blooms along the whole stem, from top to bottom.			
<b>Papaver nudicaule 'Summer Breeze Mix'</b> is an Iceland poppy with brightly colored flowers ranging from yellows to oranges. It grows to 12" and is ideal in mass plantings. Zone 3.			
<b>Penstemon 'Blackbeard' PPAF</b> is named after the famous pirate for its black-purple foliage. Pretty lilac flowers appear along dark stems followed by seed pods. It grows to 34" and is hardy in zones 3-8.			
<b>Penstemon hybrida ‘Watermelon Taffy™ PP#24293</b> has watermelon-pink flowers with white throats along sturdy bloom spikes. It can bloom for much of the summer and grows to 18". Does well in the landscape or in containers and the bees and butterflies love it. Zones 7-9.			
<b>Phlox paniculata ‘Flame™ Purple Eye’ PP#16437</b> has large, fragrant blooms during the summer. The foliage has good disease resistance and forms a compact plant growing to 18". Zones 3-8.			
<b>Phlox paniculata ‘Ka-Pow®’ varieties 'Pink' PPAF and ' White Bicolor’ PPAF</b> are part of a new series that features well branched plants with vibrant colors and mildew tolerance. Zones 4-9.			
<b>Phlox subulata hybrid (Hybrid Spring Phlox) ‘Bedazzled Lavender’ PPAF</b> can bloom a bit earlier than subulata varieties and is covered in colorful star-shaped flowers. It is a moderate grower that can form a groundcover over time. Zones 4-8.			
<b>Phlox subulata hybrid (Hybrid Spring Phlox) ‘Pink Minuet’ PPAF</b> is a hybrid phlox that blooms in between subulata and paniculata varieties. It grows to 10" and has rosy pink flowers over dark green foliage. Zones 3-8.			
<b>Platycodon grandiflorus (Balloon Flower) ‘Pop Star™ varieties: ‘Blue’, ‘Pink’</b> have large flowers atop compact plants growing to 7". Easy to grow in the landscape or in pots. Zones 3-9.			
<b>Rose (Miniature) 'Parade®Gigi' PPAF, 'Patio Hit®' varieties: 'Darla™' PPAF, 'Fiesta ™' PP#11509, 'Yumi™' PP#26868, and 'Snow Bride'</b> have attractive green foliage with bushy habits and range from 1-2' tall. <b>'Gigi'</b> is the shortest, growing to 12", and has red and white blooms. <b>'Darla'</b> is a rich red; <b>'Fiesta'</b> is a magenta-pink; and <b>'Yumi'</b> is a bright yellow. <b>'Snow Bride'</b> has pure white blooms.			
<b>Salvia greggii (Autumn Sage) ‘Mirage™’ varieties ‘Cherry Red’ PP#28527 and ‘White’</b> are 2 more varieties of this popular series. The grow to 14" and bloom from mid-spring into summer. Zone 7.			
<b>Salvia nemorosa ‘Sallyrosa™ Jumbo Pink ’ PPAF</b> is a pink perennial salvia growing to 16". It is long blooming and drought tolerant once established. It should be deadheaded to help repeat blooming. Zones 5-8.			



<b>Sedum 'Steel the Show' PPAF</b> has blue-green foliage and rose pink blooms in late summer. It makes a good groundcover as it grows only about 8". Zones 3-9.			
<b>Sedum 'Little Miss Sunshine' PPAF</b> is a groundcover sedum with dark green foliage topped with bright yellow flowers in the summer. Zones 3-9.			
<b>Sedum telephium 'Touchdown™ Flame' PP#26079</b> is an upright, well branched, summer blooming sedum. It has dark foliage that ages reddish brown and olive-green at the tops of the stems. The flower heads are creamy yellow. Zones 4-9. <i>Limited Quantities.</i>			
<b>Sempervivum 'Sunset'</b> is a smaller hen and chick that is heavily tipped with red or orange with a green center. The colors change with the seasons.			
<b>Stachys monieri 'Hummelo'</b> is the 2019 PPA Plant of the Year. Spikes of rose-purple flowers rise above textured green foliage during the summer. It grows to 20" and is hardy in zones 4-8.			
<b>Syringa (Lilac) 'Bloomerang® Dwarf Pink' PPAF</b> is a reblooming pink that grows 2-3'. This sweetly scented lilac is easier to tuck into smaller spaces. Proven Winners®.			
<b>Verbena rigida</b> is a drought tolerant, easy to grow plant that we have had in our garden at Mary's for years. It grows 1-2' and has pink-purple blooms during the heat of the summer. While it is zoned for warmer climates, it has overwintered in our garden for several years. <i>Available late Spring.</i>			
<b>Veronica hybrid 'Moody Blues® White' PPAF</b> is a tidy veronica with snowy white bloom spikes through the summer. It grows to 14" and is hardy in zones 4-9.
